

Prof. Dr. Mehmet DURMAN



Prof. Dr. Mehmet Durman, was graduated from ITU Chemistry-Metallurgy in 1982; in 1989 he received his Ph.D. at the University of Birmingham-Aston, where he worked as a researcher between the years of 1989-1990 for his post-doctoral studies. He was appointed as an assistant professor in 1990 to ITU Sakarya Faculty of Engineering, and then became an associate professor in the same faculty in the year 1992.

After lecturing as an associate professor in the Faculty of Engineering Department of Metallurgical Engineering in Istanbul University between the years 1993-1996, Prof. Durman was entitled as a full professor at the Faculty of Engineering- Department of Metallurgical Engineering in Sakarya University in 1996. 1997-1998, he served as the Dean of the Faculty of Engineering at the University of Sakarya, in 1998-2001 as the vice Rector, between the years 1999-2003 as the Dean of the Faculty of Engineering, and finally from 2002 to 2010 he served as the Rector of Sakarya University. Prof. Dr. Mehmet Durman has done scientific research especially in relation to issues of quality assurance and national qualifications framework within the Bologna process, he has worked as the executive member of many national and international commissions and working groups relating this area. Prof. Dr. Mehmet Durman has been the member of the Department of Mechanical Engineering at the Faculty of Engineering and also the Rector of İstanbul Bilgi University since September 2015.
